



#### Living Planet Index, World



The Living Planet Index (LPI) measures the average decline in monitored wildlife populations<sup>1</sup>. The index value measures the change in abundance in 31,821 populations across 5,230 species relative to the year 1970 (i.e. 1970 = 500%).




 Population: A population is a group of individuals of the same species that live in the same geographic area. A species will often have multiple or many populations, each living in a different area.






#### **Dependency of - and impact on Biodiversity**



#### **Risk of biodiversity loss for water retention**







#### Impacts and dependencies: example

Driver	Related Ecosystem Services	Impact	Dependency
Land use change	Water retention, flood prevention, real estate value	Soil loses its water storage ability: Flooding occurs	Decreasing real estate values
(Toxic) Waste generation	Nutrient cycling, habitat provision, water provisioning	Soil acidification, land and water contamination	Scarcity and increased raw material prices, increased regulation





- Biodiversity impact is about our **interaction** with natural systems
- Complex: multitude of drivers for biodiversity loss and many benefits
- Specific to sectoral (value chain) and geographic **context**
- It is not only about impact on drivers but also dependency on biodiversity & ecosystem services
- LEAP (TNFD) provides a very useful approach
